The National Road Fund Agency (NRFA) in its 2022 operational budget had made a provision for the procurement of Spare parts and Accessories. It was intended that part of the proceeds could be applied to eligible payments under the Contract for the Supply and Delivery of Point of sale machines.

Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the Public Procurement Act of 2020 and the Public Procurement Regulations of 2011.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from NRFA, Procurement Unit and inspect the soft copy Bidding Document upon request.

Preferential Procurement will be considered as follows:

- a) For a citizen-influenced company, by – 4%
- b) For a citizen-empowered company by – 8%
- c) For a citizen-owned company by – 12%
- d) For domestically manufactured goods by a citizen influenced, citizen-empowered and citizen-owned company by – 15%

A complete set of Bidding Documents in English language may be purchased by interested bidders upon payment of a non-refundable fee of ZMW500.00 or its equivalent in any freely convertible currency at the prevailing exchange rate through E-GP System.

Bids will be submitted online through EGP. Late bids will be rejected.

A Pre-bid meeting will be held on Friday, 22nd January, 2022 at 10:00hrs via ZOOM.

Bids will be opened online **VIA EGP on Friday, 4th February, 2022 at 10:00hrs.**

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration duly signed and sealed by the Guarantor(s).
